President's Letter

VISTAS

In the January LPR board meeting an issue was raised re expenditures on the Post since the Web Only distribution was abandoned at the end of 2012. A work item was taken to understand costs associated with the Post.



or other LPR expenses at board discretion. Our loyal Post advertisers contributed nearly \$7,000.00 last year.

The board considered the above and at the February Board of Director's meeting & voted to increase the price paid for a subscription from

Ultimately Bill Jump dissected all 70 transactions from 2013 through the end of 2015. The key findings are as follows>

MagCloud was initiated as the source of our print distribution of the Post. The unit cost of a 40 page issue has not changed since inception of our engagement with MagCloud. The cost to LPR is comprised of the number of pages in an issue plus US Postal Service shipping to the number of subscribers. The change in cost is solely due to the increasing number of print subscribers. The nominal cost is approximately \$8 per issue and the price paid by subscriber is only \$1 per issue. There is another cost involved in Post distribution. To communicate Post availability and maintain our distribution list we pay a 3rd party to maintain a distribution list and send an eMail notifying the members of availability of the Post and sending out the Mid Month Blast. PCA National provides \$15.50 per year per member which can be used to subsidize the Post

\$12 per year to \$36 per year. This increase will be effective 4/1/16 for new subscribers, and 1/1/17 for all subscribers.

Please be reminded that the Post is a national award winning newsletter for our region.




