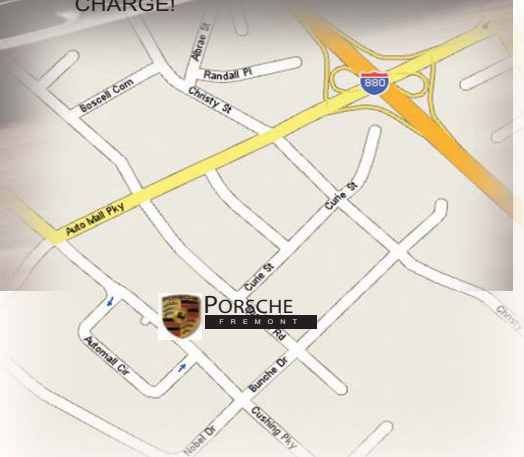
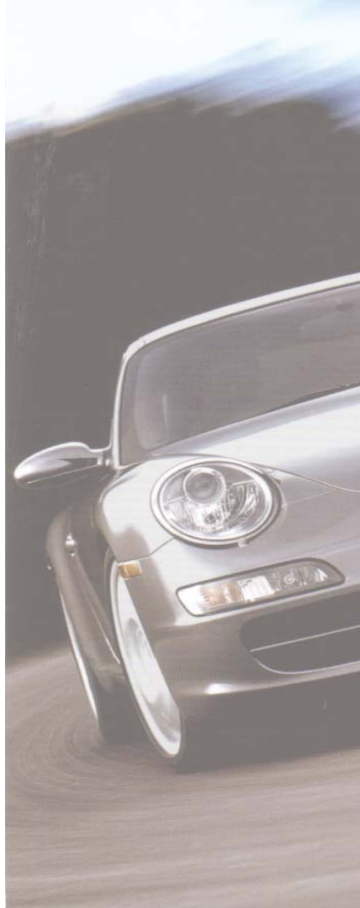

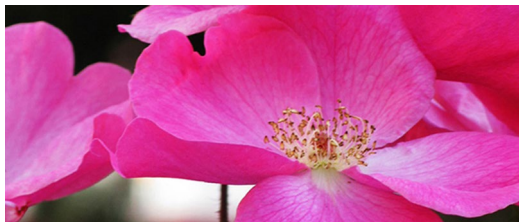
highway to the power plant.
